

OFFICIAL RULES – MINI-MOTO DAYS

Mettet-XP

Article 1 – Purpose

Mini-moto days are recreational and educational, non-competitive riding sessions held on the Mettet-XP Dirt-Track for kids, beginners, intermediate and expert levels. They aim to allow participants to drive safely, progress and become familiar with driving on a circuit.

Any participation implies full acceptance of these rules.

Article 2 – Opening hours

1. Morning driving: **09:00 – 13:00**
2. Break: **1:00 pm – 2:00 pm**
3. Afternoon Driving: **14:00 – 18:00**

Participants must arrive at least **30 minutes before their first session**.

Mandatory briefing at 8:30 am.

Article 3 – Organisation of sessions

The pilots are divided into 3 groups:

1. Children & beginners
2. Intermediaries
3. Experts

The organization reserves the right to change the composition of the groups for reasons of security or homogeneity.

Article 4 – Conditions of participation

1. Registration required online or with the organization on site (+10 euros)
2. Insurance form
3. Compliance with the rules of the circuit

Financial participation

1. PAF: **€40 online and €50 on site**
2. Optional day insurance: **€20**

Section 5 — Mandatory Equipment

Access to the track is allowed only with:

1. Homologated full-face helmet
2. Proper motorcycle equipment
3. High-top motorcycle boots
4. Cross or road gloves
5. Recommended back protector

The organization may refuse access to the track in the event of insufficient equipment.

Article 6 – Machinery and technical compliance

Mini-motorcycles must be in perfect condition:

1. Functional brakes
2. No leakage
3. Consistent sound level (95 dB max dynamic)

A technical inspection can be carried out.

Article 7 – Tyres

The following rules strictly apply:

1. Cross type rear tyres (studs) are prohibited. No worries for the front cross tyres
2. Only trail or supermoto/track tyres are allowed.

Any non-compliant vehicle will be refused access to the track.

Article 8 — Runway Conduct

Participants agree to:

1. Respect the instructions of the organizers
2. Respect other drivers
3. Avoid contact
4. Overtaking safely
5. Maintain a stable trajectory when overtaking

Any dangerous driving will result in immediate exclusion.

Article 9 – Signage

1. Green: open track

2. Yellow: danger, slow down, overtaking prohibited
3. Red: Immediate stop
4. Checkerboard: end of session

Article 10 – Liability

Each participant is responsible for any material damage or bodily injury that he or she may cause.

Accompanying persons are not allowed on the track.

Article 11 – Cancellation / weather

The organization may modify or interrupt sessions for safety reasons or weather conditions.
